

ORDINANCE 286

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MEDIAPOLIS MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 5.04 SECTION 5.04.040-LICENSE –APPLICATION FOR PEDDLERS, SOLICITERS AND TRANSIENT MERCHANTS

WHEREAS, the City of Mediapolis, by and through its City Council, in order to protect the health, welfare, and safety of its citizens, does hereby enact the following ordinance amending Chapter 5.04 of the Mediapolis Municipal Code, by amending Section 5.04.040 as more specifically set forth herein.

Section 1. Section 5.04.040 of the Mediapolis Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 5.04.040

An application in writing shall be filed in the office of the city clerk for a license under the ordinance codified in this section. Such application shall set forth the applicant's name, permanent and local address, employer's name and address, if any, the location of the last three places of such business and the nature of the applicant's business. The applicant shall provide a copy of a valid driver's license. The application fee is \$5.00. The fee for a solicitor's license is \$20.00/year. The fee for a peddler's or a transient merchant license is \$10/day, \$50/week, \$200/semi-annually, \$350/annually. In addition, a transient merchant shall post a bond as required with the Secretary of State in accordance with Chapter 9C of the Code of Iowa. The license is non-transferable, must be displayed or available at all times and is in effect only between the hours of 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM.

Section 2. **REPEALER.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. **SEVERABILITY.** If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. **WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
